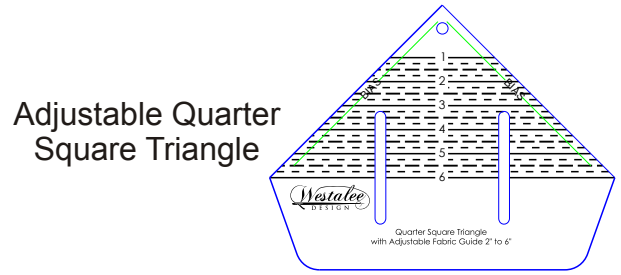
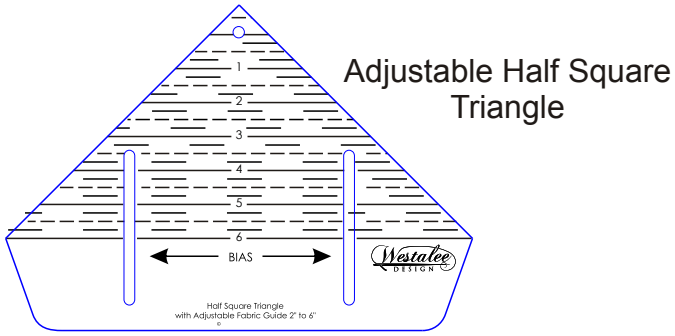
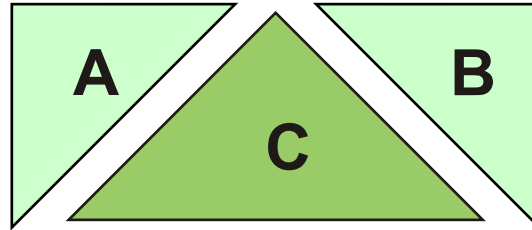



Guide for making Flying Geese using the Westalee Design Half Square Triangle and the Quarter Square Triangle.



For this example, we are going to make a 3" by 6" flying geese finished unit.



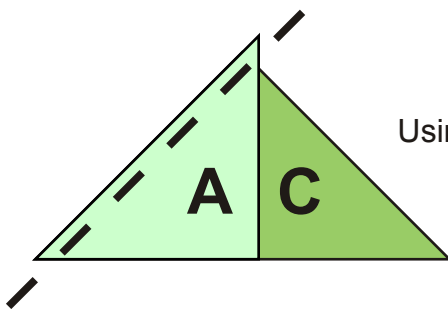
Set the Quarter Square Triangle to **6"** (this is the Goose) 

Use the Quarter Square to cut out your triangles for the Geese (instructions to cut triangles are supplied with the tool) **Piece C**

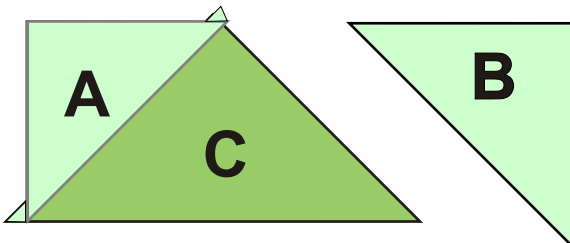
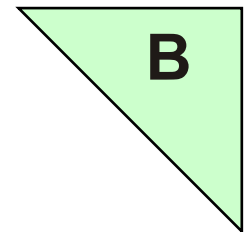
Set your Half Square Triangle to **3"** (this is the Sky) 

The setting will always be half the setting made with the quarter square triangle.

Use the Half Square to cut out your triangles for the Sky (instructions to cut triangles are supplied with the tool) **Pieces A and B**



Using a scant quarter seam allowance, join A to C



Press A open, then trim ears
Stitch B to C, press open and trim ears

Completed 3" by 6" unit.
There is no need to trim this unit to size.



**Units measuring smaller than 2" x 4" will require the use of the miniature triangles*
